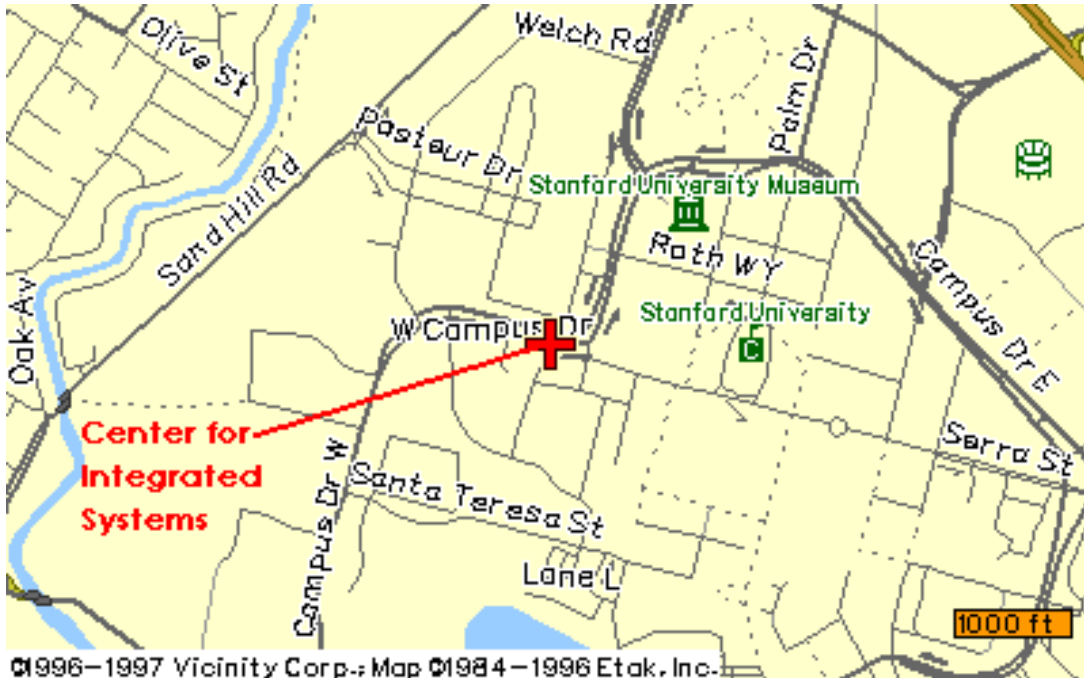


AIHA-NCS Professional Symposium

Directions to the Symposium



The Symposium will be held at the Center for Integrated Systems. CIS is located at Stanford University on the corner of Campus Drive and Via Ortega. Driving directions to CIS can be found below. The address is:

From I-280 North:

- Exit Alpine Road & turn left (east) onto Alpine Road.
- Turn right at Junipero Serra Blvd.
- Turn left at golf course onto Campus Drive West.
- Turn right onto Panama St.
- Turn left at Via Ortega.

CIS is on the right just after the stop sign, across from a large green utility plant. The parking structure is on the corner of Panama and Via Ortega.

From I-280 South:

- Exit Page Mill Road & turn right (east) onto Page Mill Road.
- Turn left at 2nd traffic light onto Junipero Serra Blvd.
- Turn right at golf course (3rd traffic light) onto Campus Drive West.
- Turn right onto Panama St.
- Turn left at Via Ortega.

CIS is on the right just after the stop sign, across from a large green utility plant. The parking structure on the corner of Panama and Via Ortega.

From 101 South or North:

- Exit Embarcadero Road West.
- Follow Embarcadero Road to El Camino.
- Cross El Camino; road name changes to Galvez St.
- Bear left on Galvez at the stadium.
- Turn right onto Campus Drive at the stop sign.
- Go 0.8 miles on Campus Drive; then turn left at Via Ortega, just past the Medical Center.

CIS is immediately on the left, at the stop sign. The parking structure is on the corner of Panama and Via Ortega.

Regarding Parking:

Parking passes will be provided for all symposium attendees. Attendees registering by June 12, 2006 will be mailed parking passes which must be displayed in the front windshield of their car. Parking passes will be mailed on or about June 14th.

Symposium attendees registering after June 12, as well as “walk-in” registrants must park in one of the metered spaces in the entrance areas of the garage, pick up their parking passes at the Symposium registration desk at the Center for Integrated Systems, and return to their car to place the pass in car’s windshield. Stanford representatives warn that parking enforcement at Stanford is quite strict; make sure to display your parking pass in your car’s windshield, and put coins in the meter at the short-term parking spaces. The AIHA-NCS will NOT pay for any parking tickets.
